H. Waorani Numbers (I/I)

Waorani is an indigenous language from Ecuador. The following arithmetic expressions involve the numbers from 1 to 10 in Waorani. The \times symbol is used to denote multiplication. The square of a number n is marked as n^2 . Each underlined sequence represents one number from 1 to 10.

- (a) měña mēña mēña mēña + mēña go mēña = ãẽmãẽmpoke go aroke \times 2
- (b) aroke² + mēña² = ãẽmãẽmpoke
- (c) ãẽmãẽmpoke go aroke² = mēña go mēña \times ãẽmãẽmpoke mēña go mēña
- (d) mēña \times ãẽmãẽmpoke = tipãẽmpoke
