(C) Levenshtein's Fine Signs (I/I)

- I. Adding a letter: \$5 Removing a letter: \$2
- 2. \$40
- 3A. May: \$33 June: \$33 July: \$28
- 3B. July May June

In May, replacing a letter – that is, adding a letter where one was deleted – is only \$5. (In other words, deletion is free if a letter is added in the same spot.) In June, moving a letter to a different position is only \$4. (You might also say something like "Addition is only \$2 if that letter was deleted elsewhere in the word.") In July, addition is \$7, but deletion is -\$1.
